STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2018-2019

The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted by the IQAC with a view for assessing the general viewpoint among the stakeholders and to develop a comprehensive survey on the specific issues to be dealt with for ensuring better quality of the Institute. The results of the survey indicate an overall quality in the teaching and learning process of the institute. The responses indicate good quality in syllabus coverage by teachers, fairness in internal exams and assessment of assignments, the teaching methodology followed as well as the innovative techniques used, and also in fostering a good teacher—student relationship. The responses show an above average quality in mentoring process, such as in identifying individual strengths and weaknesses and measures to tackle them effectively. One area to work upon is to give more effective life skills and to provide more opportunities for contact with institutes pertaining to the field of study. This has to be studied critically and all efforts are to be made to attain quality in this aspect. Another are of concern is the use of modern technology more effectively. Steps are to be taken for providing adequate teaching skills in the use of technological pedagogy through the conduct of college—level training sessions by experts in the field.
