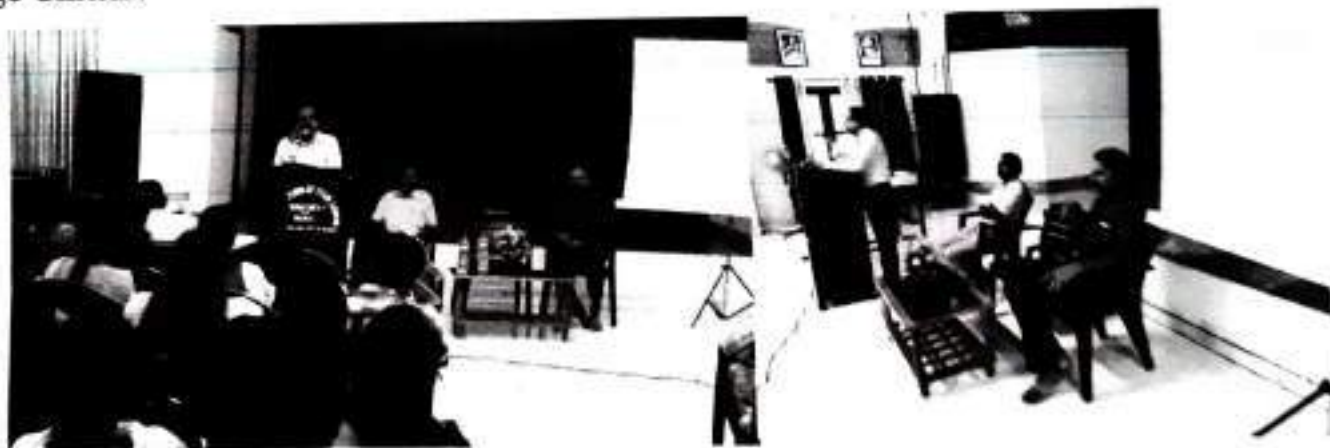
One Day Workshop On LOGIC
